Sub: 41st All India Police Science Congress at Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

Bureau of Police Research and Development is organising 41st All India Police Science Congress in collaboration with Uttarakhand Police at Dehradun from 21st to 23rd June, 2011. This Congress will be inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttarakhand and Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Home) Shri Gurudas Kamat will be the Guest of Honour on this occasion. The conference will be inaugurated at 0930 hours on 21st June 2011.

2. The congress will have 15 sessions including the inaugural and valediction to discuss 12 identified themes (copy attached). DsGP of States/UTs have been requested to nominate delegates to attend the congress. Delegates from Central Armed Police Forces, CPOs, States and Union Territories are likely to participate in the congress and deliberate on various identified themes.
