Sub: Developing Specialist Investigator (DSI) Training Courses under Training Intervention Plan Scheme of BPR&D : Inviting Proposals from States/UTs and CAPFs/ Universities for the year 2020-21: Reg.

BPR&D runs a fully sponsored scheme titled “Developing Specialist Investigator” (DSI) to train and develop specialist investigators/ subject experts in various fields with the object of ensuring that eventually every district in the country has at least 02 specialists for investigation of all kinds of crime. List of subjects with their duration and indicative syllabi for each of the subjects is enclosed as Annexures – ‘A’ & ‘B’.


2. All the courses are offered for sponsorship on the rates approved by the MHA vide their Office Memorandum No. 23011/40/2011-PT, dated 07.08.2014 & vide F.N.23011/40/2014-PT, dated 18th June, 2019. The same are enclosed as Annexures – ‘C’ & ‘D’. The approved rates for courses of the duration of 5 days and 10 days are enclosed along with a check list/ guidelines as Annexure-‘E’.

3. These courses are meant for ranks from Sub Inspectors to Dy.SP, up to the age of 45 years. The participants securing first position in each of these courses are likely to be considered for advanced training abroad, subject to Government clearance. Therefore, a proper record of tests and results in respect of all the participants should be maintained as per the proforma at Annexure-‘F’ and feedback of all the participants sent to the BPR&D along with the course report.

In the interest of capacity building of the Indian Police, you may consider directing the Training Division/ Police Training Academies under you to plan and propose training programmes at your training institutions during the year 2020-2021.
