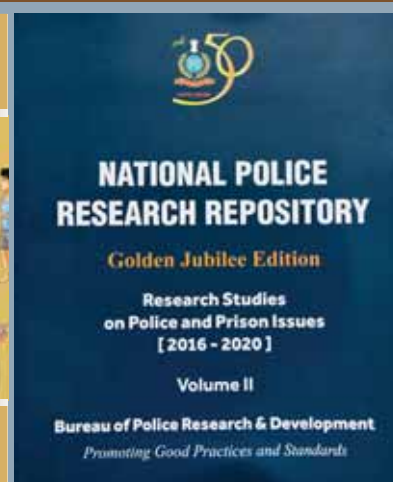

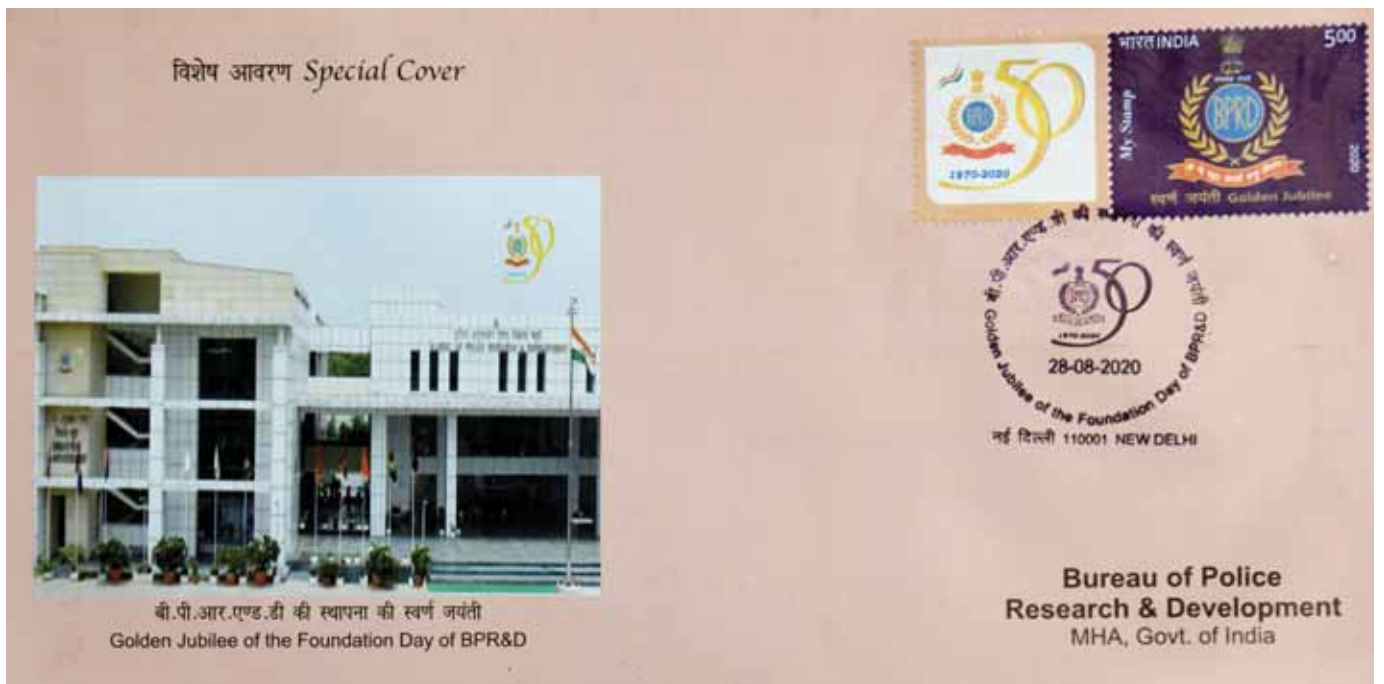

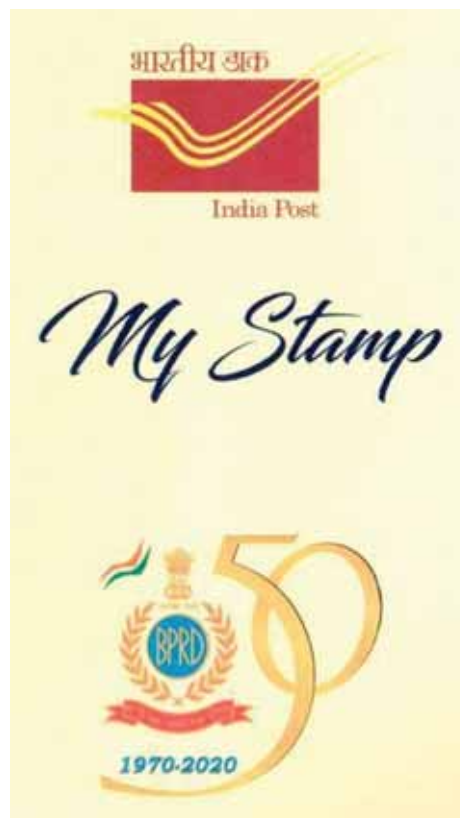

Golden Jubilee National Police Perspective Management Course

August 31 - Sept. 04, 2020
New Delhi

As part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations of the BPR&D, the Training Division conducted a 5-day online training course styled 'Golden Jubilee National Police Perspective Management Course' for officers from States/UTs, CAPFs and CPOs, of the ranks of additional SP to IG, from August 31-Sept. 04, 2020. The course sensitized the participants to a wide variety of professional concerns, including national security, de-radicalization, cyber crime, investigation/ prosecution, police leadership, gender issues, VIP security, predictive policing, disaster management, etc. Faculty was drawn from within and outside the BPR&D for interactive sessions. All lectures were very well received. ●

ONLINE COURSES AT CAPT & CDTIs

- **CAPT Bhopal** successfully conducted 8 (eight) online training events, including 2 online courses and 6 webinars in the month of July-2020. These courses were on Soft Skills for Police Officers and Induction Course for NCB Officers. A total of 2,132 officers from various state police forces, correctional services, prosecution department and CAPFs participated in these online training events. In addition, one online distance course on Soft Skills for 10 days and a workshop on Crime Against Women & Children were also conducted through e-School through Moodle.
- CAPT also conducted 6 (six) online training programs. This includes Training of Trainers - IDC; Investigation of Road Accidents course; Management Principle course for Prison Officers, three workshops on human trafficking & its effects on children and woman safety and one webinar for Prosecution Officers. A total of 765 officers from various state police forces, correctional services, prosecution department and CAPFs were trained in these online training events.
- CAPT, as one of the nodal centers, successfully hosted **Smart India Hackathon - 2020**, a nation-wide initiative to provide students a platform to solve some of the pressing problems. Considering the current COVID-19 pandemic, the software edition of Smart India Hackathon - 2020 was conducted w.e.f. 1-3 August, 2020, through an online platform, thus avoiding mass gathering.
- **CDTI, Chandigarh**, conducted, 10 (ten) Online Courses from July to September, 2020, in which 257 police officers participated. Further, mock online classes were conducted during this period for in-house faculty, in which lectures were delivered on different subjects for them.

Their Cyber Faculty, conducted the following sessions :

- » Day long training for officers of Cyber Cell, Amritsar, on Cyber Crime related cases.
 - » Webinar on "Mobile Forensics and Cyber Crime-Recent Challenges" for students of the Deptt. of Information Technology, Punjab University, Chandigarh.
 - » Online Session on "Cyber Crime Investigation" for IPS Probationers (72R/R) of Haryana Police.
 - » Online lecture on "Cyber Forensics and Challenges" for students of Sri Krishna College of Engg. and Technology, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.
- In order to continue serving its mandate despite the constraints imposed by the pandemic, the **Central Detective Training Institute (CDTI), Hyderabad**, launched its online training initiative. A total of 13 courses were conducted in which 293 police officers and prosecutors were trained. CDTI, Hyderabad, introduced 04 courses for the first time on (i) Social Media Investigation & Data Analytics (ii) CDR & IPDR Analysis (iii) Dark Web, Crypto Currency & Block Chain Technology, and (iv) Disk Forensics. ●

One month online training of Ladakh Police Officers from August 17 to September 16, 2020, on the IPC, CrPC and the Indian Evidence Act was conducted at the CDTI, Ghaziabad. 20 Police Officers underwent intensive training, online. A first ever course of this nature, the training of Ladakh Police Officers in laws and legal practices of the Indian mainland, was a significant step in integrating Ladakh with the rest of the country. It was equally an important initiative of the BPR&D, for the larger national cause. During the valedictory function, Shri. S.S. Khandare, IGP, Ladakh Police, thanked the distinguished panelists and the BPR&D for equipping the officers at the cutting edge with much needed legal knowledge.●

Covid-19 Antigen Testing

The Modernisation Division organised a Covid Screening Camp for all the employees at the BPR&D and NCRB in collaboration with the Antigen Detection and Testing Centre of the Delhi Govt. on 17-18th Sep., 2020. 429 members of the staff from the BPR&D and the NCRB were screened for Covid-19 (Rapid Antigen Test). 13 from the BPR&D and two from the NCRB tested positive.
