#### Functions of the UAV

- Surveillance with UAV instead of Helicopters
- It can perform direct patrolling armed with cameras for assessing traffic.
- Search for missing persons using heat sensitive devices in case of disaster management.
- UAV can hover around the scene during hostage situations
- Can be used in maritime surveillance.
- Multiple flights possible, this means no man fatigue involved.



### Course for Women Police Officer

A three-day training program for middle level women police officers on “Self Development and Conflict Management” was conducted by the Institute of Social Sciences, New Delhi, from 25th to 27th March 2010. Nineteen Participants from different states of the country attended the Course. A discussion on the topics like “Problems of mainstreaming women in the police” and “Challenges before the women police officers and measures to overcome them” was held during the course.

## 3rd All India Prison Duty meet

The 3rd All India Prison Duty meet held from 4th to 6th February, 2010 in Bhubaneswar, Orissa in joint collaboration with Bureau of Police Research and Development and Directorate of Orissa Prisons. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Orissa, Sh. Naveen Patnaik inaugurated the meet on the opening

ceremony on 4th February, 2010 at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar. Inaugurating the occasion the Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik announced that a Mahatma Gandhi Academy of Correctional Administration will be set up in Bhubaneswar and two more open jails will also be set up in Sambalpur and Berhampur. Among others, Sh. Man Mohan Praharaj, Director General of Police, Odisha, V. Tyagarajan, Additional DG (Prisons) and Shri A. R. Kini, Director (R&D), BPR&D and Dr. B. V. Trivedi, Deputy Director (Res. & Correctional Administration), BPR&D were present on the occasion. A total of 579 prison officers of various ranks from 18 States and UTs actively participated in the meet.

The national event was aimed at achieving cooperation and coordination among the prison officers of the country and to provide a platform to exchange professional notes and share best practices in prison reforms. The indoor and out door competition were held to hone the mental and physical skills.
